

PUPPETRY

OBJECTIVES

Club members explore the art of puppetry, with emphasis on creativity and self-expression, through team-work, role-playing, and public performance. Different styles of puppetry are explored. Original shows are written and designed by members and developed from script to performance, in both group and solo presentations. There is no competition for this club.

RULES FOR EXHIBITION

- 1. Only members enrolled in the puppetry club may exhibit.
- 2. Members must have attended at least 70% of club meetings.
- 3. Each member is allowed to perform in all exhibiting classes.

CLASSES

1. Group Performance, non-competitive:

All members should be well-rehearsed and ready to perform any group shows developed and practiced during the year's regular meetings.

2. Solo Performance, non-competitive:

This class is optional for all members

Any solo show a member has performed more than once throughout the year may be performed, as well as any shows a member has independently developed. Assistance from another member, a leader, or a parent is permissible in this class, including the operation of other puppets.

3. Puppet-related Presentation/Demonstration:

All standard members may give a presentation on puppetry-related topic appropriate for their age/grade.

AWARDS

All participants will receive noncompetitive club ribbons.
