

SEEING EYE

OBJECTIVES

Members will learn how to raise and train a well-socialized puppy for the Seeing Eye, Inc.

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR EXHIBITION

1. Exhibitor must be an active 4-H Club member consistent with Somerset County 4-H guidelines for the Seeing Eye project; have 70% attendance, have an up to date project book, have participated in a club, county or state demonstration.

2. Puppies shown at the fair must be an age consistent with the Seeing Eye Exposure guidelines for the current 4-H year.

- 3. Exhibitor must dress neatly.
- 4. Exhibitor must remain with dog and have dog under control.
- 5. Puppies in all classes will be judged on:
 - a. Relationship with 4-Hers
 - b. Grooming
 - c. Leash handling
 - d. Obedience appropriate for their age

6. During evaluation the judge will not take off points for a dog's natural deficiencies as is done in regular dog shows.

CLASSES

Puppies will be judges in the following classes according to age.

- 1. Class A
- 2. Class B
- 3. Class C
- 4. Class D
