PERFORMING ARTS – OPEN DIVISION

To give all 4-H members an opportunity to develop their talent and perform on the Clover Theater Stage at the 4-H Fair during one of three daily "Somerset 4-H Talent Showcase" (SHOWCASE)

RULES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR EXHIBITION

- 1. Any 4-H member may perform.
- 2. If the 4-H member has never before performed during an "SHOWCASE" show, the 4-H member must register by May 1st to be invited to audition at the 4-H Center (later in May). Contact the 4-H Center to register.
- 3. If the 4-H member has performed during a prior year's "SHOWCASE" show, or if the 4-H member gave a performance for a County Presentation, no audition is necessary. The 4-H member will be contacted during the month of May.
- 4. All entries must be classified as "Solo Performance" or "Group Performance".
- 5. Members may perform solo only once per class during the 4-H Fair's "SHOWCASE" show. However, members may also perform again with a group.
- 6. All lyrics must be memorized. However, an instrumental CD or cassette may be used as an accompaniment.
- 7. During the Fair, each performer must complete a registration form (obtained from the Stage Manager) before the beginning of the "SHOWCASE" hour.
