### Attention ALL 4-H Clubs in New Jersey!

**WorldWideWriters.Ink** – the writing and illustration arts club from Somerset County – announces its latest **STORY Writing Contest**. In this one, you can enter any one of the Subject categories and submit your work in the **Word count that you choose: 6, 10, 17 or 25**.

**Rules:** Your submission **MUST tell a story**.  
The Word count **MUST BE EXACT** (6, 10, 17 or 25 words)  
**No titles allowed**; your Words will tell the story.  
- **Submissions with titles will be disqualified.**

**Eligibility:** Any regular 4-H Youth member (4<sup>th</sup> grade and up).

**Entries:** Only one (1) submission per entrant in each Word Count category.  
- **Maximum submissions per person = four (4)**

**Deadline:** **April 29, 2022 - Noon**

NOTE: **One (1) entry per e-mail**, as judges may vary per category

**Prizes:** **Winners (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>)** will have their entry published in ***A Walk Around the Writers Block***, the magazine of the **WorldWideWriters.Ink**, which will be available in print and/or on-line form during the **Somerset County Fair - August 10-12**.
